Rotary's Four-Way Test is an ethical guide for Rotarians to use for their personal and professional relationships. Charles Woodroof told of its creation by Herbert J. Taylor in 1932. But, Charles noted that the ethical foundation was nothing new. Even Socrates used a version with his Test of Three. He was known to abide by three principles in speaking about others: (1) Is what you say absolutely the truth? (2) Is what you are saying something good about that person? (3) And, finally, will that information be useful. As Charles said, it was a test of Truth – Goodness – Usefulness.
