Fellow Rotarian Chris Brand spoke on the Friends of Disabled Adults and Children (FODAC) at Thursday's FODAC is the largest Home Medical Equipment (HME) reuse provider in Georgia. In fact, this 501(c)3 nonprofit provides over \$10 million in home medical equipment and services each year at little to no cost to recipients in 49 states. Their focus is on providing durable medical equipment at little or no cost to the disabled and their families, and they seek to enhance the quality of life for people of all ages who have any type of illness or physical disability. FODAC is unique in that they repair used and often discarded medical equipment using only donations. 2012-2013, FODAC nrivate In redistributed more than 5000 pieces of medical equipment including hospital beds and wheel chairs. Brand oversees the FODAC facility in Stone Mountain

that serves Georgia. There are 30 drop-off sites around the state and in Atlanta area for donations of used equipment. These donated items are refurbished in the 65,000 square foot facility in Stone Mountain by volunteers. That facility alone has provided over 35,000 wheel chairs, and the estimated retail value of the equipment they have refurbished and given to those in need is over \$100 million. The HME repair program is not the only aspect of their offerings; they also provide services such as home and vehicle modifications for the disabled, and they offer support for nursing home transitions, disabling injuries, disability groups, and emergency preparedness, recovery and mitigation. FODAC even promises to assist local Rotary clubs in efforts to develop local and international service projects. To learn more about FODAC, please visit their website fodac.org.
